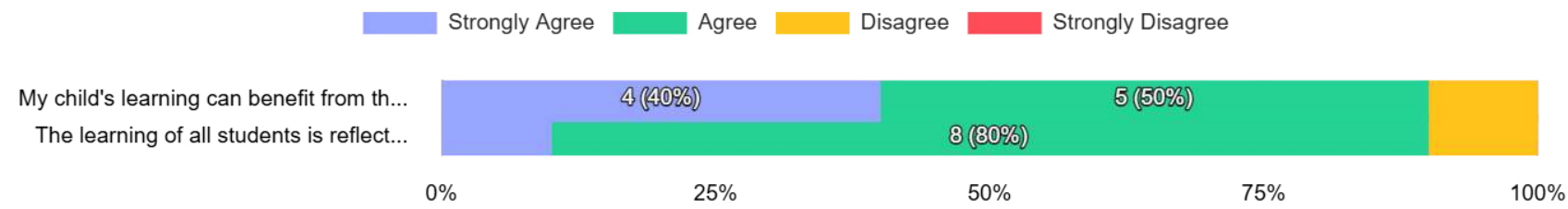

There is no area for students and parents to provide feedback on whether a teacher is effective, fair and equitable in their classrooms. Grade 7 EFI teachers have been largely disappointing in all these areas.

The plan is poorly written and stays away from real data. Scoring a « 1 » is nearly impossible: it means the child can't even accomplish the tasks even with assistance. So it's not a bragging rights to say that 98% of kids have a 2 or up. Or telling us that it's « 2% above CBE average » doesn't say much either. In order for the report to be useful, it needs to be transparent and accurate, not glorified.

I feel that the schools SDP is in line with CBE. From a personal point of view, and I'm not sure how much of this can be implemented, but in order to build preparation for college etc, is it possible to have the students do some kind of assignments/projects or extra learning at home? Other than this, the feedback I get from my child is positive. I have noticed his enthusiasm about all subjects he is taught. I appreciate the effort of the school, and the teachers in educating our children.

Recording the improvements is more important than the raw data vs Canadian norms.

Transportation within CBE alternate programming is extremely poor, with students expected to walk 4.2kms to the bus stop and then home after school. Paying \$260 for this service is outrageous.

It's just so many activities and fees are one after the other. It would be good if it's subsidized further.
