Report from school	<p>School development plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Please refer to the school website for information. Both the school development plan and powerpoint presented at the School Council meeting are available on the website. ● Questions - how has the new school tech policy affected learning? Answer - fewer phones have created way fewer issues. ● Camp Kindle was very successful. ● Sailing trip will also be phone free ● Eastern Canada will not be phone free, but restricted. ● Parent involvement is waning, how can we engage more parents? Family capacity has changed compared to previous years. ● November 9th was the Schools Indigenous Education Professional Day. All schools and all teachers were involved in this. ● Question: How subscribed are parent teacher interviews, are 5 min interviews valuable? Answer - they are fully subscribed, many teachers meet outside of the timetable. Fundamentally there is simply not enough time to meet with all parents. ● Question: Are parents given the opportunity to book a longer appointment prior to opening to all students. Answer - yes, teachers were being proactive in booking appts in addition to vetting parent requests. ● Question: is there another approach to the 5min interview? Perhaps an open house.
